

Petition Against the Intake Center at the Bedford-Atlantic Armory

The Bedford-Atlantic Armory is a poor choice as a location for an intake center for New York City's homeless men. With 6.3 times the median number of social services beds in Brooklyn, the community that is home to the Bedford-Atlantic armory is too over-saturated to provide adequate support or a positive environment for newly homeless men. Under the City's proposed plan, homeless men will have to travel long distances to streets where crime and drug abuse are evident to reach a shelter that has a reputation so bad many of the homeless fear to enter. Placing an intake center at the Bedford-Atlantic Armory Shelter is bad for Central Brooklyn and bad for the homeless. **By signing this petition, I am stating my firm opposition to an intake center at the Bedford-Atlantic Armory.**
