5. Males born after December 31, 1959, must be registered with Selective Service to work for the USPS.
6. **Applicants must have a valid driver's license from the state in which they live and must also demonstrate and maintain a safe driving record. Successful applicants will be afforded (89) days in which to obtain a CDL driver's license in order to maintain their employment.**
